In 2008, Metro won voter support for a \$125 million bond, a portion of which it promised would establish an off-site sanctuary / reserve for the eight Oregon Zoo elephants (now five; Tusko and Rama were euthanized in 2015; Packy in 2017). In February 2016, Metro cancelled plans to build the preserve, citing the less than four-acre Elephant Lands "huge" space for the then six remaining elephants and up to 13 more elephants.

The Oregon Zoo elephants continue to suffer from a variety of painful and life-threatening illnesses and conditions caused by their captivity. The reason given for Packy's euthanasia was his TB, a disease rarely found in the wild elephant population.

The on-site Elephants Lands is nothing more than a sand lot, and is inadequate to restore the elephants' physical and mental health.
